#### **1. DAWR Biosecurity - Inspection and Cleared for Delivery (Sydney Autostrad, Melbourne and Fremantle)**

Workscope;

1. Discharge container from vessel to segregated quarantine stack - Patrick (included in base stevedoring tariff)
2. Supply and lay salt/bait and monitor for Giant African Snail (GAS) if required by Patrick Terminals in Melbourne and Fremantle only - outside pest control contractor arranged by Container Operator at its risk and expense for other Patrick Terminals or other non-GAS pests
3. Move container to inspection area and place on inspection stand - Patrick
4. One Patrick employee to assist operation in conjunction with DAWR Biosecurity officer - Patrick
5. DAWR Biosecurity officer(s) to be arranged by Container Operator at its risk and expense
6. If cleared for delivery return import container to pre-delivery stack - Patrick
7. Delivery to beneficial cargo interest road truck or to on-dock rail (where applicable) - Patrick (included in base stevedoring tariff)

#### **Rates: Sydney Autostrad**

Items 3 + 4 + 6; **AUD 216.30 per 20ft/40ft container + GST**

#### **Rates: Melbourne and Fremantle**

Items 2 + 3 + 4 + 6; **AUD 232.20 per 20ft/40ft container + GST**

#### **2. DAWR Biosecurity - Inspection and ordered into Quarantine at Sydney Autostrad**

Workscope;

1. Discharge container from vessel to segregated quarantine stack within Sydney Autostrad ocean terminal - Patrick (included in base stevedoring tariff)
2. Supply and lay salt/bait and monitor for Giant African Snail (GAS) if required - outside pest control contractor arranged by Container Operator at its risk and expense
3. Move container to inspection area and place on inspection stand - Patrick
4. One Patrick employee to assist operation in conjunction with DAWR Biosecurity officer - Patrick
5. DAWR Biosecurity officer(s) to be arranged by Container Operator at its risk and expense

6. If ordered Into Quarantine for wash or fumigation, return container to quarantine area for later delivery to road transport.
7. Lift from quarantine area to flat bed trailer for transfer to an accredited provider of choice at Port Botany - Patrick (included in the base stevedoring tariff)
8. Road transport from terminal to an accredited provider within the port precincts and required services to be arranged by Container Operator at its risk and expense (required services may include but are not limited to container lifts to/from road truck, baiting, monitoring, wash or fumigation).

Items 3 + 4 + 6; **AUD 216.30 per 20ft/40ft container + GST.**

Wash Cost – service provided by others

Fumigation Cost – service provided by others

**3. DAWR Biosecurity - Inspection and ordered into Quarantine at Melbourne and Fremantle**

Worksopce as per 1. above (except not delivered to the beneficial cargo interest but to Container Operator).

**Rates: Melbourne and Fremantle**

Items 2 + 3 + 4 + 6; **AUD 232.20 per 20ft/40ft container + GST**

**4. For containers ordered into quarantine by an DAWR Biosecurity officer at Patrick Terminals**

**Melbourne and Fremantle** – practice is that containers are moved offsite to be dealt with as directed by DAWR Biosecurity (monitor, wash or fumigate); Container Operator arranges this, at its own risk and expense, with an accredited service provider of choice within the port precincts.

**5. DAWR Biosecurity affected containers - any other services required other than those outlined above (including transshipment containers); price on application.**

**6. Terms and Conditions;**

1. Patrick Standard Conditions of Contract to apply unless otherwise covered by Terminal Services Agreement.
2. Credit terms; as per Terminal Services Agreement.
3. Infrastructure Levy is payable in addition, if and where applicable.
4. Subject to periodic review or to take account of any legislative changes at time of effect.

**1. DAWR Biosecurity - Inspection and Cleared for Delivery**

Patrick inclusions and worksopce;

1. Patrick Terminals to place affected containers into the CargoLink exchange area – included in base stevedoring tariff. (If any affected containers are allocated to a temporary stack position within the ocean terminal for later transfer to the CargoLink exchange area, the supply and laying of salt/bait and monitoring is to be undertaken by an outside pest control contractor arranged by Container Operator at its risk and expense. Any additional lifts will be charged at AUD 122.80 per 20ft/40ft container + GST.)
2. Movement of container from CargoLink exchange area to processing/storage area

3. Supply and lay salt/bait and monitor all areas involved in process
4. Internal movements of containers within CargoLink site
5. Arrange DAWR Biosecurity officer(s) to attend site to carry out inspection
6. Supply employee to assist operation in conjunction with DAWR Biosecurity officer
7. Place container on inspection stand and carry out inspection
8. Return cleared container to pre-delivery stack when DAWR Biosecurity cleared
9. Delivery of container to nominated carrier on presentation of approved documentation

**1.01 AUD 239.35 per 20ft/40ft container + GST.**

**Rates: Patrick Terminals**

**1.02 AUD 106.50 per 20ft/40ft container + GST (if applicable).**

**2. DAWR Biosecurity - Inspection and ordered into Quarantine and External Wash**

Patrick inclusions and workscope;

1. Patrick Terminals to place affected containers into the CargoLink exchange area – included in base stevedoring tariff.
2. Movement of container from CargoLink exchange area to processing/storage area
3. Supply and lay salt/bait and monitor for Giant African Snail (GAS) if required in all areas involved in process – other pests
4. Internal movements of containers within CargoLink site
5. Arrange DAWR Biosecurity officer(s) to attend site to carry out inspection
6. Supply employee to assist operation in conjunction with DAWR Biosecurity officer
7. Place container on inspection stand and carry out inspection
8. Perform cleaning function as directed by DAWR Biosecurity officer (includes employee(s), use of platform, use of wash bay and supply of water, cleaning materials and waste disposal
9. DAWR Biosecurity officer re-inspects container
10. Cleared container returned to pre-delivery stack when DAWR Biosecurity cleared
11. Delivery of container to nominated carrier on presentation of approved documentation

**Rates (External Wash):**

**2.01 AUD 321.75 per 20ft container + GST**

**2.02 AUD 450.10 per 40ft container + GST.**

**3. Fumigation of Containers;**

Patrick inclusions and workscope;

1. Move container from inspection area to Fumigation area
2. Arrange fumigators to attend site to carry out fumigation, **fumigate/monitor** at Giant African Snail (GAS) rate 128 grams per cubic metre or as otherwise ordered by DAWR Biosecurity.
3. Remove cleared container from Fumigation area and place on wash bay for re-inspection
4. Cleared container returned to pre-delivery stack when DAWR Biosecurity cleared
5. Delivery of container to nominated carrier on presentation of approved documentation

**Rates:**

**3.01 AUD 552.95 per 20ft container + GST.**

**3.02 AUD 880.85 per 40ft container + GST.**

**4. DAWR Biosecurity affected containers - any other services required other than those outlined above (including transshipment containers); price on application.**



**5. Exclusions;**

- DAWR Biosecurity officer attendance at site
- Handling of transhipment cargo POA

**6. Patrick Port Logistics – Terms and Conditions**

1. Patrick Standard Conditions of Contract to apply to all services provided.
2. Payment terms strictly seven (7) calendar days from date of invoice.
3. Surcharge applicable for full Reefer containers – POA.
4. Surcharge applicable for Dangerous Goods and Over dimensional /Out-of-Gauge containers handled – POA.
5. Containers receive three free working days from clearance – thereafter storage and handling charges applicable.
6. Infrastructure Levy is payable in addition, if and where applicable.
